Share the Love cloth diaper banks grow through a distributed model to provide a scalable framework around local resources to meet local needs. Cotton Babies provides program structure, supporting printed materials, educational programs, host training, data support, and coordinates the communication process between host volunteers and families in their communities.

Share the Love is now a nationally accessible cloth diaper bank providing needy families access to relovable cloth diapers with approximately 100 sites nationwide.

SHARING THE LOVE THROUGH A DISTRIBUTED MODEL

Share the Love uses local resources through a distributed model to provide a consistent, scalable framework; a key for sustainability.

Share the Love is a growing network of host sites located throughout the United States. Each host site is operated by volunteers responsible for collecting cloth diaper donations in their area. The host site then loans donated diapers to needy families in their community. Education is also a key part of the process. Hosts work with the families, teaching them how to properly use and care for their cloth diapers and answering any questions they might have.

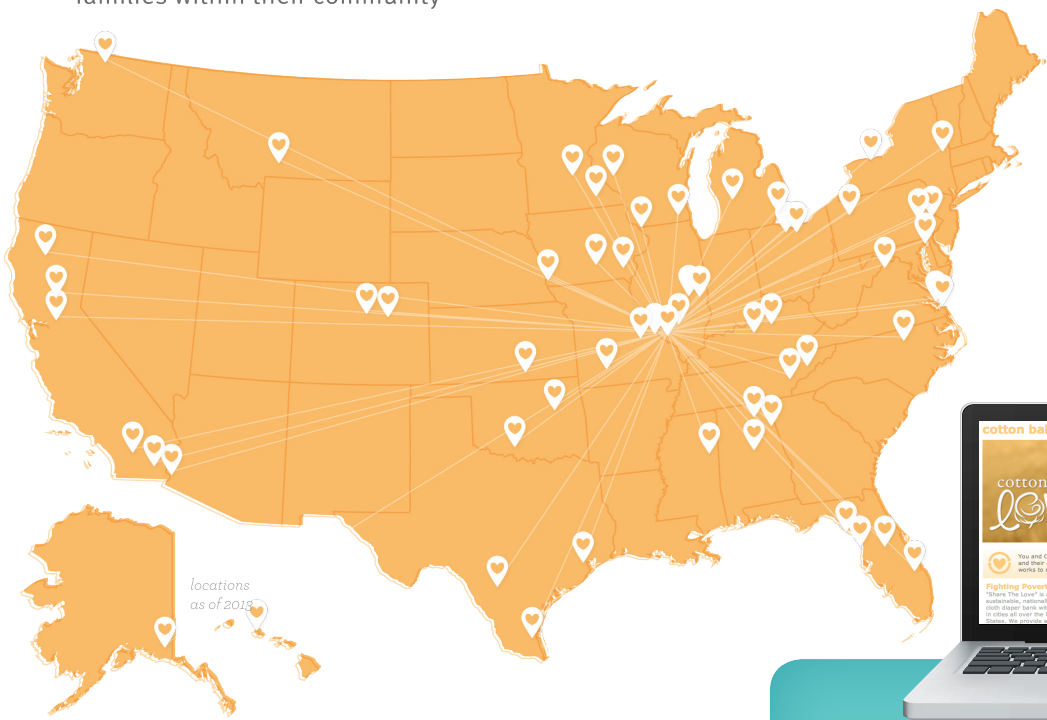
COTTON BABIES PROVIDES:
